Reciprocal Borrowing Policy (RBP)

- 1. Reciprocal borrowing is defined in the Illinois Administrative Code (23 IL ADC 3030.10) as "the right of a person holding a valid library registration card from a full member public library or a library system to borrow on site from all the other public libraries that are full members of the library system without using interlibrary loan mechanisms."
- 2. The Crystal Lake Public Library will abide by the RAILS Resource Sharing Policy.
- 3. Reciprocal Borrowers are subject to all current policies, fines, and fees of the Crystal Lake Public Library.

4. Lending restrictions:

- a. The Crystal Lake Public Library Board of Trustees will honor written requests from other libraries to restrict reciprocal borrowing by its patrons.
- b. Should the Crystal Lake Public Library experience continual reciprocal imbalances as a net lender, the Board of Library Trustees may restrict borrowing by the patrons of those selected libraries that contribute most significantly to that imbalance.
- c. The Crystal Lake Public Library may place reciprocal borrowing restrictions on new, developing collections.

5. Borrowing restrictions:

Should the Crystal Lake Public Library experience continual reciprocal borrowing imbalances and become a net borrower, the Board of Library Trustees may request that other selected libraries limit loans to CLPL reciprocal borrowers.
